Cynthia Greer is the Director and Senior Mediator of the California Academy of Mediation Professionals (CAMP). She has mediated over a thousand cases dealing with wrongful termination, sexual harassment, racial discrimination, and educational issues, among other areas. In addition, she is a federal mediator and trainer for the United States Postal Service and the United States Medicare Program. An associate dean at Pepperdine University School of Law for more than 17 years, she has taught Interviewing, Counseling and Planning at the law school since 1988. Her doctorate degree in organizational management along with her two masters degrees in community counseling and dispute resolution enable her to integrate advanced concepts from the fields of psychology, communication, and conflict resolution into the mediation process. Dr. Greer is responsible for the overall management of CAMP. She directs the convening and mediation aspects of the program, initiates and oversees community education and fund-raising efforts, recruits mediation volunteers, and assists in mediation trainings. In addition, she mediates cases, is the liaison with court and county personnel, and directs the student externship program. Dr. Greer is a past president of the Los Angeles chapter of the Association for Conflict Resolution, a member of the California Dispute Resolution Council, and a member of the American Bar Association, Alternative Dispute Resolution Section Training Committee.
